"I'm getting back to my musical roots, singing and playing the folk songs I grew up with in the '70s!" exclaims the singer/guitarist. Currently performing most Sundays at Tanner's Coffe Shop in Playa Del Rey, CA, Diane Hubka explores songs from the Americana melting pot: Folk, Acoustic Country, Blues, and Texas Swing - songs by Bob Dylan, Neil Young, Bonnie Raitt, Joni Mitchell, Emmy Lou Harris, The Allman Brothers, and John Prine.

Originally from Western-Maryland, this Blue-Ridge Mountain-bred artist grew up in a musical family and learned violin, trombone and guitar from an early age. "My mother was in a folk group in the '60's called the Brandywine Singers. At home I played guitar, my sister played piano, and we all sang harmonies."

During her senior year in college, Diane studied jazz guitar and developed a passion for jazz that took her to Washington DC, then New York City and later to Los Angeles. She received a fellowship from the National Endowment for the Arts and headlined at notable New York venues Blue Note, Birdland and Knitting Factory. In 2005 she relocated to Los Angeles, where she quickly became a member of the local jazz elite, performing at such iconic venues as the Jazz Bakery, Catalina's, Vitello's and Charlie O's and recording with Anthony Wilson, Joe La Barbera, Christian Jacob and Peter Sprague.

With six internationally acclaimed CDs, she has headlined throughout the US as well as Turkey and Japan. Sponsored by The Sinatra Society of Japan, she appeared in Tokyo, Osaka and Yokohama, where she "dazzled the Japanese audiences with her intelligent improvisations and energy." (EASTWIND IMPORT)
